### ❖ Chinese Classes

Three academic hours of Chinese courses are offered every morning, Monday through Friday (9:00am-11:35am), and are divided into 3 levels: Beginner, Elementary, and Intermediate. Classes are mainly taught in practical oral Chinese to help students improve their listening and speaking abilities in a short period of time.

### ❖ Chinese Culture Experience Activities

Chinese calligraphy, Chinese painting, Chinese tea art, Chinese knot tying, Chinese Kung Fu, etc.

### ❖ “One on One” Mentorship Between International and Chinese Students

To deepen international students’ understanding of Chinese culture, and help them familiarize with life on campus, our university will assign each international student a Chinese student partner on enrolment day. This partner will assist attendees with their daily needs and help them experience local culture.

### ❖ Economic Lecture and Local Business Tour

To broaden international students' understanding of China's economy and society, we offer interesting lectures on Chinese economy. Along with organized field trips to local corporations and businesses, these lectures offer students first-hand experience of Shanghai's dynamic corporate culture.

### ❖ City Tour

City tours introduce students to important historical and cultural landmarks, as well as Shanghai's surrounding tourist attractions.



◆ **Application Deadline** : June 15, 2018

◆ **Enrollment Date** : June 29, 2018

◆ **Duration** : July 2, 2018 to July 27, 2018

◆ **Eligibility** :

- Non-Chinese citizens in good health between 16 to 60 years of age at the time of application. Applicants under the age of 16 must submit a certificate of guardianship.
- Must hold valid passport and visa.

◆ **Fees** :

- Application Fee: 400 CNY.
- Program Fees: 3000 CNY. (Including tuition, culture courses, business visits, etc.)
- Travel: 1 Day Shanghai City Tour: CNY 500.  
2 Day Tour at Suzhou or Hangzhou: CNY 1280
- Insurance Fee: 400 CNY.

## Dormitory Facilities:

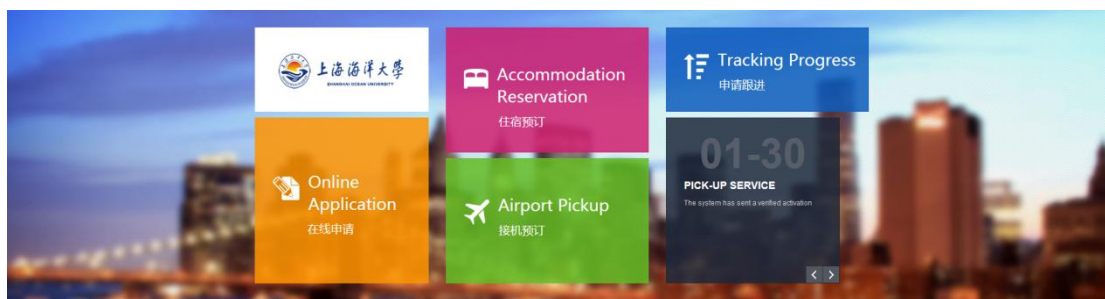
- All rooms in Apartment No.1 are arranged as single units containing 4 rooms each. Each 4-room unit shares a common bathroom equipped with 2 showers (hot water), sink, and 3 toilets. A public common area including a study lounge, activity room, as well as kitchens and laundry rooms is located on the first floor.
- Each room in Apartment No. 2 is equipped with its own private bathroom providing 24 hour's hot water.
- All rooms are equipped with an air conditioner, bed, desk, wardrobe, internet/telephone outlets, and other basic necessities.



## Application Procedure

### 1. Online Application

Please visit Shanghai Ocean University admissions web-site (admissions.shou.edu.cn or gjxy.shou.edu.cn) to apply. Provide all required personal information and documentation. Upload clear and legible photocopies of your passport, as well as several personal passport style photos. Include your name, photos, place of birth, date of birth, and visa expiration date. Fill out the registration form and make sure to select the summer program.



### 2. Email Confirmation

After successful online application, we will send confirmation to the email address provided.

### 3. Application Fee Payment ( 3 Payment Methods )

#### 4. Enrolment

After confirming receipt of the application form, required materials, and the application fee, we will notify applicants of admission within 10 business days.

#### ❖ Visa Application

After students receive admission confirmation from SHOU, they will be sent a "Visa Application for Study in China" (JW202 Form) and an Admission Notice, along with policy guidelines, academic calendars, maps, and other materials. The above documents must be provided to your local Chinese embassy or consulate for visa application.

#### ❖ Pick-up Service
